Dr. Catalina realized that there are moments in our life when **“we as every human being, either rich or poor, need a hug that touches our souls”**.



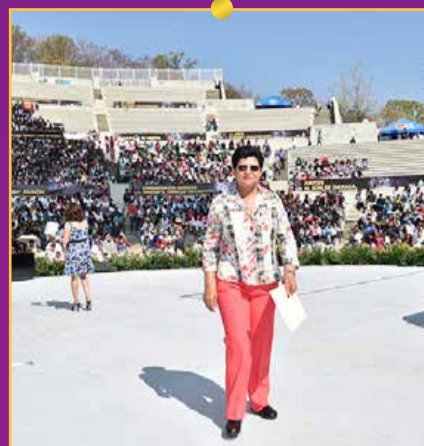
I want more people in the world like Catalina Mendoza, inspiring souls that make changes, human beings with passion for the things they do, common people, committed to social life and the welfare of others.
