Thanks to the vision and efforts made by Dr. h.c. Catalina Mendoza Arredondo, the CMT founder, who set up a board of volunteers in 1995, and in 1997 it expanded CMT as a Civil Association. That fact allowed the accomplishment of the social welfare elements, considering health as the main pillar to support human and social development.

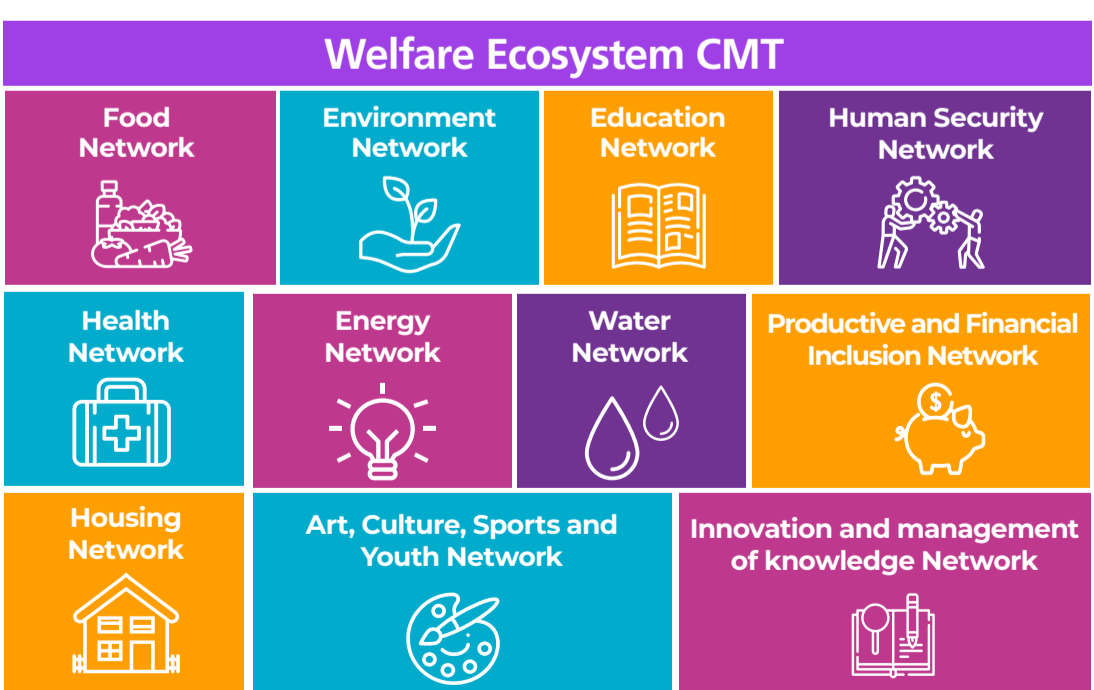
Congregación Mariana Trinitaria contributes to social integral welfare by implementing subsidy programs, which are oriented to organized community groups to foster social cohesion. Therefore, they potentialize civil service through a program based on co-investment and co-responsibility to have a bigger impact, and to reach objectives regarding social action programs that are promoted by the different levels in the government.

This way, CMT became an alternative for public advocacy as it fits and complements the production of public goods as planned by the three levels in the government and other supportive participants. Each one of them has witnessed for many years the results and impacts caused by those actions.

The three main pillars in Congregación Mariana Trinitaria are:



Due to previous experiences, now it is possible to have the CMT Welfare Ecosystem, which is a programmatic and operational platform that allows short-term, medium-term, and long-term results by implementing a variety of contemporary and innovative programs. The purpose is to reduce the main lacks in health, social and economic development, and welfare, in order to increase public policies and financial resources to benefit people.



All those networks consist of integral solutions based on social organization and the efforts made by the beneficiaries so that they are able to improve their own life conditions. The objective is to reduce poverty indexes and the lack of services that is endured by many families in Mexico.
